Things to Think about for the Camp Competition

- Kids On Stage Summer Camp includes both theater classes and dance classes, as well as classes in stage combat, improvisation, puppetry, stagecraft, and storytelling. KOS Summer Camp is open to students of all skill levels aged 4 to 14.
- The camp theme is a guide for each group's showcase. It should be narrow enough to give each teacher ideas, but broad enough that each group can have a different play or dance.
- A theme should be appealing to both boys and girls, and should not make any group feel excluded.
- Recent camp titles have included "Under the Big Top," "Happily Ever After," "Around the World," "Deep in the Heart of Texas," "A Tribute to Broadway," "Mystery Madness," and "History of America."
- The camp theme should make you excited about coming to summer camp!

Camp Competition Rules (By entering, you agree to follow these rules!)

- Entries must be submitted between Dec. 1, 2008, and Jan. 5, 2009. Entries received before Dec. 1 or after Jan. 5 will be disqualified.
- Entries must be the original creation of the entrant. No entry can include copyrighted material belonging to another author. ("Harry Potter Goes to Summer Camp" would be disqualified.) Each entry must have a single author. No entries can be submitted by groups or pairs.
- Each author may submit up to 3 ideas for the theme, and must use this form to do so.
- If two entries from different authors happen to be identical, only the first entry submitted will be considered.
- Entrants must be 18 or under through January 5, 2009.
- Creator of the winning entry will receive 1 full scholarship to 1 session of Kids On Stage Summer Camp 2007 or 1 full scholarship to 1 session of the High School Summer Workshop. Winner's name and age will be listed in the camp brochure and on the website.
- Scholarship is transferable, but only to brothers and sisters of the winning entrant.
- The winning camp title will be announced at the January 2009 Kids On Stage Open House. Entrants need not be present to win.
- All entries become the property of Main Street Theater. Main Street Theater reserves the right to edit or otherwise alter contest entries.
- Winning entry will be selected by Main Street Theater staff. Judges' decisions are final. Main Street Theater reserves the right not to name a winner.
- We will confirm the receipt of all entries by email, if one is given, or by regular mail. If you have not received confirmation within 10 days of submitting your entry, please call the Director of Kids On Stage at 713-524-9196 x 104 to confirm that we have received your entry.
- Winner will be notified by phone.
